Minutes of the meeting of the BCA Town Amenities Sub-Committee held on **Wednesday 23 January 2013** at 8 pm at 13 Doctor's Commons Road, Berkhamsted.

1. Minutes of the meeting of <u>Tuesday</u> 11 December 2012 were agreed.

2. Matters arising

2.1 PC highlighted the presence of an incongruous sign in the Conservation Area, at Alsford Wharf in Castle Street, showing private parking restrictions. SJ to write to Conservation Office at DBC and also contact the Enforcement Officer.

3. Planning and Environment

- 3.1 PC noted that the consultation for the Tring, Northchurch and Berkhamsted Urban Transport Plan was currently open (until 1 March) with an exhibition at the Civic Centre on Saturday 26 January. All to review the Plan during February to see if it necessary for BCA to submit comments on the consultation. **ALL**
- 3.2 The consultation document for the proposed Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) was discussed. Different rates are to be applied in different areas across the borough, and it was agreed that GB should write to DBC to protest at the punitive rates proposed for Berkhamsted. Post meeting note: GB e-mailed James Doe of DBC on this, who responded that the charging rates were based on evidence collected by a major bank but would "ultimately....be tested at the Public Examination into the final draft charging schedule, which will be conducted by an independent Examiner." BCA to consider whether a formal representation should be made to DBC.
- 3.3 Plans were reviewed for weeks of 12/19/26 December and 2/9/16/23 January.
- 3.3.1 10 Shrublands Avenue (4/00014/13/FHA) SJ to comment on the unsuitability of using a 'composite' door in the Conservation Area.

4. Transport (including Parking)

4.1 The Chairman thanked those involved in completing pavement surveys for the Town Council. PC advised that the Town Council was struggling to arrange a meeting with the framework contractor to try to resolve these and other highways issues affecting the town.

5. Canal

5.1 Towpath repair works between Castle Street and Waitrose bridge were expected top be completed by March 2013.
